If you have chosen this exhibit, we hope you will find some of these things helpful. On the list of “ingredients” it asks for a Mylar Aluminized Reflecting Sheet. In simpler terms, window tint. This can be found at Pep Boys in the car accessories aisle. We advise you to get the standard window tint. (You will get much more than what you need for the project.) They will try to sell you the glue for application. It depends on if you want to spend more money, but you don’t need the glue to put the exhibit together. Next, don’t buy cloth tape. Any sticky tape is better. For the base, two wood blocks with rubber bands works as well.

When it comes to actually showing your exhibit, you have to stay very energetic and excited. It helps to ask if anyone wants to change faces with their friend and other lines like that. Tell the people doing your exhibit what they will see. Stay positive and don’t give up if the people don’t see the exhibit pan out right away. Enjoy and have fun with this exhibit! ☺
